## **SAFETY SERVICES & LICENSES COMMITTEE**

Regular meeting of the Safety Services and Licenses Committee was held on Monday, September 14, 2020 via Zoom webinar.

### **II. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING:**

**Chair** asked that the license application for La Casa LLC be taken out of order. He stated that documents were dropped off in the Clerk's Office today of objectors and since that is possibly 51% of the remonstrants, this Committee cannot act on this at this time. He would like this continued to next month's meeting in order for the Solicitor to research this before we go forward.

On motion by Councilmember Brady, seconded by Councilmember Donegan, it was voted to continue the license application for La Casa LLC to next month's meeting.

**Councilmember Brady** stated that he is very sorry to hear that we are continuing this at this time. He honestly thinks this is an attack on a small business and also of diversity. This business has been operating for approximately three years without a problem or any issues. He thinks that this is one person attacking this business and we should do everything in our power to fight this and fully approve granting the liquor license.

**Nick Hemond, Esq.**, appeared to represent the applicant and stated that his client will be delivering to the Clerk's Office signatures of people in favor of this license application and the Solicitor may want to look at that.

**Councilmember Vargas** asked if the Committee can be provided with copies of the signatures that were filed with the Clerk's Office. Solicitor stated that that should be fine.

Roll call was taken on motion to continue the license application for La Casa to next month's meeting and motion passed on a vote of 5-1. The following being recorded as voting "aye": Councilmembers Stycos, Vargas, Hopkins, Paplauskas and Council Vice-President Favicchio -5. The following being recorded as voting "nay": Councilmember Brady -1.

Mr. Simoneau stated that that is around the time that they combined Patriot and MTG routes and the dispatch was rerouting their routes and they had drivers learning new routes and new trucks and he thinks that they were out of sync in terms of the town and what time they could start pick-up in different towns. Then the pandemic hit and had new drivers. He stated that he feels that since July, they have been getting back into a rhythm and have been letting drivers know that they cannot pick up before 7 am. He also stated that going forward, this should not be a problem.

**Council Vice-President Favicchio** stated that all these times are two or three weeks ahead of the schedule. He asked Mr. Simoneau how long he has been in charge of this business. Mr. Simoneau stated that he is not in charge, he is the Business Manager there. He was at MTG when the two companies combined so he is not privy to the history with Patriot to some of these stops.

**Councilmember Stycos** stated that the people from the public can explain this problem better than anyone regarding open fires that produce smoke.

**X. FIRE DEPARTMENT: (Cont.)**

**Tracy Breton**, 174 Columbia Ave., appeared to speak and stated that she is not familiar with the fire pit problem in the City, but there is a businessman who owns a great business in the Edgewood shopping plaza and her backyard abuts this business. The business owner runs a smoking business. He is smoking food. No notice was sent out to the residents about this business going in there and now she can't keep her windows open in her house when he is open because it smells like a fire pit inside her home. There is firewood piled up approximately 10' high in the back of her house. If this is happening throughout the City, we need to address the situation.

**Councilmember Hopkins** asked what the address of the business is. Ms. Breton stated that the name of the business is Keanes and he has all the appropriate licenses for the restaurant.

**Councilmember Hopkins** stated that Mr. Licker has called him on a number of occasions regarding this issue.

**Chair** asked Chief MacIntosh for update on the correct law for fire pits and if anything should be changed.

**Chief MacIntosh** stated that in 2017, we revised the Ordinance and the one thing that the Ordinance lacks is enforcement.

**Andrea Yates**, 30 Tucker Ave., Floor 3, appeared to speak and stated that she recently moved out of the City mainly because her neighbor continuously burned a fire pit. The fires would go all night until 1-2 in the morning.

**Chair** suggested possibly adding a time limit for the person to burn the fire. Councilmember Stycos agreed.

**Jacqueline Denby**, 7 Harbor Terrace, appeared to speak and stated that the real issue is enforcing the Ordinance. Her neighbor burns 2' from her wooden fence. She has addressed concerns to the neighbor at no avail. This is a serious matter that needs to be addressed.
