Lupino, Council President Resolved that, WHEREAS, there has recently been a significant increase in the rodent problem in several areas of the City of Cranston; and WHEREAS, rodents bring with them a whole host of diseases and dangers; and WHEREAS, one of the most important strategies in eliminating rat infestations is depriving food sources for the rodents; and WHEREAS, it has been shown in various communities across the country that eliminating or curtailing the use of bird feeders during an ongoing rodent infestation has been successful in reducing the number of rodents in a community; NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Cranston City Council hereby respectfully requests that the residents of the City of Cranston place only one bird feeder per property until the rodent infestation problem has been significantly reduced; and **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Administration take proactive steps to educate, alert, and request the cooperation of citizens to voluntarily place only one bird feeder per property until the rodent infestation has been \*abated. reduced.
