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## **CONSENT ORDER**

This matter came before the Honorable Associate Justice McBurney for hearing on Plaintiff's Complaint and it is hereby agreed by the parties that it is:

## ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED:

- 1. The Council's denial of Plaintiff's petition to rezone his property located at Plat 35, Lot 2 (the "Property") from A-80 to A -20 is inconsistent with the Comprehensive Plan which expressly calls for the property to rezoned to A-20 upon the request of the landowner;
- 2. The Plaintiff may submit an application to rezone the Property from A-80 to A-20 without it being barred by the doctrine of administrative finality or res judicata for having been previously denied by the Defendants;
- 3. If the Plaintiff does submit a petition to change the zone of the Property from A-80 to A- 20 it is recognized by the Defendants that such a change is called for expressly in the Comprehensive Plan but nothing else contained herein shall constrain the Defendants from conducting their normal review of a petition for zone change nor shall this Consent Order otherwise compel the Defendants to approve a petition submitted by the Plaintiff;

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- 4. If the Plaintiff submits his petition, the Council shall otherwise review the petition in its ordinary course pursuant to applicable State law and City ordinances, however, no sponsorship by a City Council member shall be required;
  - 5. This litigation is stayed for a period of 3 months; and
- 6. Once the petition is acted upon by the Defendants, in conformity herewith, this matter shall be dismissed with prejudice, without fees and costs.
