## Instructions

1. **Complete and sign the application** - Use a black or blue pen to fill in your information and select the eligibility category that applies to you.
2. **Return your application** - Must be received by your local board of canvassers by the deadline. Postmark must be dated on or before the deadline date.
3. **Tracking your mail ballot** - Visit [vote.ri.gov](https://vote.ri.gov) to sign up for **BallotTrax**. You will receive notifications on the status of your mail ballot application and mail ballot delivery information. Mail ballots are sent to voters approximately 3 - 4 weeks before the election.
4. **Receiving your mail ballot** - Your mail ballot packet will have your mail ballot, instructions, voter's certificate and the required postage-paid envelope to return your voted mail ballot to the State Board of Elections.

## Notice to applicant

- Any registered voter can use this form to request a mail ballot for Rhode Island elections.
- Your application is a matter of public record, but your vote is confidential.
- If anyone attempts to intimidate or unduly influence you, or interfere with your right to vote, contact your Local Board of Canvassers.
- Any person knowingly and willfully making a false application or certification or knowingly and willfully aiding and abetting in the making of a false application or certification shall be guilty of a felony and shall be subject to the penalties provided for in section 17-26-1, [RIGL 17-20-8(D)].
