

(The following is not a verbatim transcript of comments or discussion that occurred during the meeting, but rather a summarization intended for general informational purposes. All motions and votes are the official records).

SAFETY SERVICES & LICENSES COMMITTEE

Regular meeting of the Safety Services and Licenses Committee was held on Monday, April 7, 2025 in the Council Chambers, City Hall, 869 Park Ave., Cranston, Rhode Island.

I. CALL TO ORDER BY THE CHAIR:

The meeting was called to order at 6 P.M. by the Chair.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A. Approval of the minutes of the March 3, 2025 Regular meeting.

On motion by Council Vice-President Wall, seconded by Councilman Andujar, it was voted to approve the minutes of the March 3, 2025 regular meetings and they stand approved as recorded. Motion passed unanimously.

IV. PUBLIC COMMENT

Ethan Hartley, 11 Lexington Ave. appeared to oppose to the Liquor License and Entertainment License applications for El Laham Restaurant and stated that he has concerns with this business. He reiterated comments he made at the last meeting. If new owners prove to be good neighbors, then this could be re-addressed.

Rebecca Hartley, 11 Lexington Ave., appeared to oppose to the Liquor License and Entertainment License applications for El Laham Restaurant and stated that there are already noise issues, very very serious traffic issues that are taking place and this business has not shown

that they care about the neighborhood at all. By passing this, you will be driving away actual Cranston residents, people who want better for the City. She asked the Committee to please listen to the residents.

Ernesto Perez, 435 Pontiac Ave., appeared to oppose to the Liquor License and Entertainment License applications for El Laham Restaurant and stated that the current business owner has zero respect for basic noise and speeding and trash. By adding Entertainment and Liquor, it will not improve anything.

Resident of 16 Lexington Ave., appeared to oppose to the Liquor License and Entertainment License applications for El Laham Restaurant and stated that he is concerned about the direction this neighborhood is going in. She has been a lifelong resident of Lexington Ave. and her family has owned this home since 1959. She stated that change is great, but just in the last few years, the businesses that have come into the Rolfe Square area have not really done anything to adhere to the established sound Ordinance, guidelines, sanitary guidelines with trash disposal. She is seriously considering moving and it is the last thing she wants to do.

Tom Sarkisian, 437 Pontiac Ave., appeared to oppose to the Liquor License and Entertainment License applications for El Laham Restaurant and stated that he echoes what the previous speaker stated. He asked that this be tabled for a while and maybe look at it further on down the road. It is a little premature to just award them this coveted liquor license that is going to impact the neighbors so greatly.

Chair asked that the above three items be taken together.

Hanna and Charbed Kosseifi appeared to speak.

Chair asked if sale has gone through. Mr. Kosseif stated that they have a purchase and sales agreement and the lease agreement. Sale should be by April 15th.

Chair stated that this business has been operating since December without a Fire inspection. That is unacceptable. They do not have a license to have food, they do not have a liquor license and they never have had a liquor license so for this Committee to grant a liquor license, there is going to have to be a lot of changes and it won't be just open all day and night. It will be very strict. The Entertainment License that they have now from 4 p.m. to 10 p.m. Thursdays thru Sundays only and the neighbors who are present have been woken up at 3:30 in the morning, 2 in the morning by parties in the parking lot. Those people have been shown no respect and they are coming to advocate. They do not want a liquor license. They do not want Entertainment, but her biggest concern is this business has been operating without a Fire safety inspection. Mr. Kosseifi stated that they agree, but they have nothing to do with the business until they take ownership of it.

Chair stated to the applicant that this Committee can't grant anything because they are not the owners, they are not in possession of the business. Mr. Kosseifi stated that they have a lease that started on April 1st and purchase and sales agreement and they sent that all to the Clerk.

Chair asked the Committee, as a courtesy to the applicants, to continue this. Mr. Kosseifi stated that they are getting yelled at by people and by the Committee and they have absolutely nothing to do with this. They are trying to improve this building and this business. He is being attacked for somebody else's issues and problems. As a new business owner, once you own the business, Chair stated to the applicant that he can file an application and get his Victualling License, Entertainment and even ask for the Liquor License. Right now, he does not have a Liquor License and it is not just a transfer, but her suggestion would be to any business in Cranston, if you are operating or trying to operate, get your Fire inspection. Mr. Kosseifi stated that they have been in business for over twenty years and own multiple businesses and they have never had any problems or have never had any complaints with any of their businesses they own. They would like a chance to prove themselves.

Solicitor stated that he had a conversation with their attorney, McHugh, after the last meeting and discussed some of these issues. He pointed out that another issue the Committee needs to deal with apart from the complaints of the neighbors that applicant should be aware of is that there may be an issue with regard to whether or not there is a House of Worship or a Church or a School that is operating somewhere in that building because if it is, it would be within 200 feet of this establishment. Rhode Island law would now allow a liquor license to be issued so he is not offering legal advice, but this Committee and the Administration needs to do a little bit more investigation to see if that is true. No one is assuming that and no one is anecdotally saying that is the case. We operate on facts not on what we hear, but applicants should be aware that that issue is out there. He believes their attorney is aware of it.

Council President Marino stated that it is important this evening just to point out that all the applicants are asking and all this Committee is seeking is that this business meets the same standards as every other business in the City of Cranston and nothing different. Given what the residents have stated in the previous meeting and this meeting this evening, her vote, if they came before the Committee for a Liquor License, she is not going to be in favor of that. She wants to see proof that they are taking over the business and it is operating in compliance and

that the neighbors do not have any issues for an extended period of time and then she would consider a Liquor License, but right now, she is not in favor of that Liquor License right off the bat.

On motion by Council Vice-President Wall, seconded by Council President Marino, it was voted to continue the Entertainment License application motion passed unanimously.
