Past businesses at this location raced cars down the street. He asked that applicant be mindful of the neighbors.

Mr. Soto stated that this will not be happening. This is just an auto mechanic shop and nothing like racing cars.

No one appeared to oppose.

Antoin Karwashan appeared to speak and stated that this is going to be an auto repair shop.

Chair asked applicant if he has received Fire Inspection approval. Mr. Karwashan stated that the Fire Department was there today and is working on it.

Rene Brambault, 25 Bolton St., stepped to the podium and apologized for arriving late and asked to be allowed to speak.

Chair stated that public hearings have been closed and she would not be allowed to speak.

Ms. Brambault asked if the Committee could reconsider reopening the public hearings.

On motion by Councilman Paplauskas, seconded by Council President Marino, it was voted to reopen the public hearings. Motion failed on a tie vote of 3-3. The following being recorded as voting “aye”: Councilmen Campopiano, Paplauskas and Council President Marino - 3. The following being recorded as voting “nay”: Councilmen Ferri, Wall and Councilwoman Germain -3.

Under Discussion:

Councilman Paplauskas stated that he represents the area and the constituent who tried to speak earlier lives behind this business and for years there have been issues with that property with junk cars along the side and fence never repaired. There have been a lot of issues. Being a good neighbor is very very important.

Council President Marino clarified that the only reason the constituent was not able to be heard is because the opportunity was closed. She made it abundantly clear to applicant that if the Committee receives complaints of issues there, they have the right to call the business in to address those issues.

Councilwoman Renzulli stated that, while she does not have a vote, but she does live in the area and she is called by some residents that she believes call Councilman Paplauskas often, she was contacted by a resident and was told that applicant has been operating for the last two weeks prior to getting the license and yesterday the “open” sign came down. She asked applicant if he has been operating. Mr. Karwashan stated that he has not been operating. People were painting there, but not operating the business and there was no “open” sign whatsoever. There was an “Auto Sales” sign on the building and he took it down. Councilwoman Renzulli asked applicant that he be a good neighbor.

Roll call was taken on motion to approve this license application and motion passed unanimously.

1-24-02 *ORDINANCE In Amendment of Title 5 of the City of Cranston Code of Ordinances, 2005, Entitled “Business Licenses and Regulations”; Sponsored by Councilman Ferri, Councilman Donegan, and Council President Marino.*

On motion by Councilman Wall, seconded by Councilman Paplauskas, it was voted to recommend approval of this Ordinance.

Under Discussion:

Solicitor Verdecchia stated that he has not had the opportunity to compare this Ordinance with the State Legislation, which seems to cover the same topic under Title 19 of Ch. 14 and the State seems to have a very comprehensive statutory scheme which applies to this situation. He pointed out that there may be a possibility that the State may have preempted this particular area of the law and asked that the Committee keep that in mind as this is debated. He will research this in much greater depth if the Committee wishes as to whether or not the municipalities have the enabling legislation to enact this type of Ordinance, which may conflict with what the State already has in place.

Chair explained this Ordinance and the next Ordinance on the agenda. He stated that what these Ordinances are trying to establish is the burden to stop this short-term lending problem fallen on the municipalities. Woonsocket has already passed this and Providence and Warwick are in the process of passing it also. This is a Bill that was introduced over thirteen years ago in the RI State Legislation by his brother, Frank Ferri, and it has just gotten kicked down the road for years. Sometimes the interest rates from the lenders can exceed 200%. They are not trying to put these businesses out of business, they are trying to protect people that need these types of loans. He has worked on this very hard with Council President Marino, Councilman Donegan and Attorney Angell worked with him on this and he came up with the two Ordinance.

Councilman Campopiano asked if there are any of these types of establishments in Cranston. Chair stated that there is one on Dyer Ave.

Councilwoman Renzulli questioned which department would enforce this. Solicitor Verdecchia stated that, ultimately, he believes a complaint would need to be received and at that point, it would be the Committee to Show Cause them. He thinks the consumer would have to initiate it.

Roll call was taken on motion to recommend approval of this Ordinance and motion passed unanimously.

Chair stated that it is the responsibility of this Committee is to vote on all license applications applied for in the City and to make sure that businesses that apply for these licenses are in compliance. In recent months there have been three Special Safety Services meetings to provide extra opportunities for businesses to comply with the requirements. This Committee is pro-business. It was brought to his attention that 33 restaurants in this City were operating with expired license. Some for as many as three months. This, in his eyes, is a problem. Every business was reminded to renew their license and were given the opportunity to renew their license. The Office has been very helpful in getting these businesses to comply. By law, any business that is not in compliance and operating without a license, can be fined up to \$50 per day, which we have not done. He took attendance of everyone that was called in for a Show Cause this evening and asked that if the business owner is present, they raise their hand. The following businesses were called:

Chair stated that some of the licenses were issued after the Show Cause letters were sent out and the reason the applicants were asked to attend this evening is that if they were Show Caused, that meant they operated their business for a period of time without a license. If there is a problem, the Clerk is always there to help resolve the problem. If the business has not yet resolved the issue, the Committee is asking that in 72 hours, they contact the Clerk's Office and start the process to getting their license issued. After 72 hours, we are going to take the necessary steps to Cease and Desist the business. If it is a tax issue, they are to contact the Tax Collections Office, if it is a Fire inspection issue, they are to contact the Fire Department. The Fire Inspector is present this evening and he asked him to address the Committee. Armen Nich, Fire Prevention Captain, appeared to speak and stated that if someone has a problem getting in touch with his office, his personal cell number for work is 572-8441 and he works Tuesdays thru Fridays.

Solicitor Verdecchia stated that the motor vehicle licenses are treated slightly differently under our Code of Ordinances. For the people who have not renewed, he pointed out that the fines are up to \$500 for every violation and there is also a potential of six month prison sentence. Those violations will go to Municipal Court. They will not be here in front of this Committee. The Committee can take action on the license, but if the auto repair business is operating and not appropriately licensed and have not entered into a payment plan, the business will run the risk of being cited by the Cranston Police Department and they will have to appear before the Municipal Court Judge.

Chair stated that he would like to continue any license that does not resolve this within the next 72 hours to next month's meeting. He asked Solicitor if a letter could be served to the businesses that have not appeared this evening. Solicitor Verdecchia stated that all the no shows will be receiving a letter in the form of a Cease and Desist informing them of the action that was taken this evening and also informing them to heed the directive, and also informing them that they can remove the Cease and Desist as long as they comply with the Committee's directive this evening.
