



City of Cranston Announces Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Informational Session for the Perkins Avenue and Meshanticut Brook Neighborhoods

2012 New Grant Application

On Tuesday, September 27, 2011 at 7:00 p.m., Mayor Allan Fung and the City of Cranston will host an Informational Session for all home owners* impacted by the March 2010 flooding particularly in the Perkins Avenue and Meshanticut Brook (i.e. Amanda Street) neighborhoods. This session is a direct result of the Mayor's continued efforts to secure Federal funds under FEMA's Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP).

City officials will be providing details of the HMGP and the possibility of voluntary requests for property acquisition by the Federal government.

* Home owners affected by the flooding in the Pocasset River Flood Plain will not qualify under this program. The Pocasset River flooding is currently being addressed via an NRCS program.
