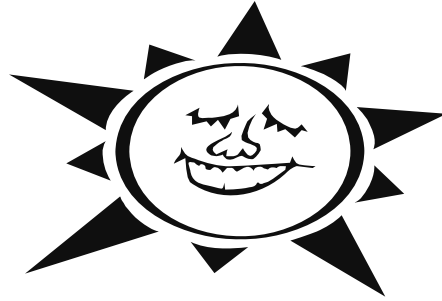

Baseball / Softball



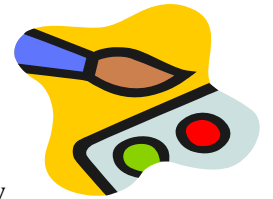

No class on August 9

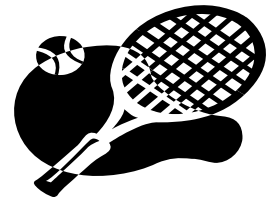

Living Arts Theater Program

This unique five week theater program teaches students grades 4 through 12 the fundamentals of the theater in a safe, fun, and friendly environment. The program focuses on acting, dance, and vocal work along with workshops in scenic and costume design. At the end of the program each student will leave knowing what is needed to put on a full scale theatrical production. The show for the summer is Disney's Jungle Book. The program runs from 12:00pm — 2:45pm Monday through Thursday at Hope Highlands Elementary. At the end of the program, there will be a full production in the auditorium on Friday, August 6 at 7pm and Saturday, August 7 at 1pm & 7pm. **Fee is \$150.** Space is limited.

This 6-week day camp program takes place rain or shine and is for ages 6-8 and 9-11. Activities include bowling, mini-golf, roller skating, swimming, various field activities, and live performances, etc. Field trips include visits to McCoy Stadium, Roger Williams Zoo, Ocean State School of Gymnastics, and Yawgoo Waterslides among others. Fee includes all admissions. Busing provided to and from all camp sites.
